

**Proposal by the Chinese delegation on the draft resolution on Human Rights  
Council dated on 01.02.06**

*OP1*

To merge OP16 with OP1. The last sentence of OP1 reads “The General Assembly shall review the status, **work and functioning** within five years.” Thus OP16 is deleted.

*OP4*

To replace “**and the right to development**” with “including the right to development” in the last phrase of the para.

*OP5e*

To reinsert “**The conclusions of the review shall be presented in a Chair’s summary.**” from 19.12.05 draft.

*OP5f*

To replace “respond promptly to deteriorating human rights situations” with “**respond to situations of gross and systematic violations of human rights**”.

*OP5i*

To merge i with j. Thus i reads “**make recommendations and submit an annual report to the General Assembly.**”

*OP6*

To delete “assume” and “in order to maintain a system of special procedures, expert advise and individual complaint procedure.”

To insert “**The review shall be objective and comprehensive.**” as the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence in the para.

*OP7*

To maintain **53** member states elected by **simple majority** based on **the principle of equitable geographic distribution**. Accordingly the seat distribution is: **Africa 15, Asia 15, GURLAC 9, WEOG 8, Eastern Europe 6.**

To delete “and shall not be eligible for immediate re-election after two consecutive terms”.

*OP8*

To delete the last sentence of the para.

*OP10*

The regular meeting time of the Council could be **2 sessions for a total duration of 8 weeks a year.**

To replace “one-third of the membership” with “**simple majority of the membership**”.

*OP11*

A separate paragraph on NGO participation is essential.

*OP13 of 19.12.05 draft*

Elements to regulate the country specific resolution are essential. The delegations is open to proposals in this regard.
