The beatification of Cardinal John Henry Newman by Pope Benedict XVI is expected to be held in September in or near Birmingham. The Newman Association have organised this conference to celebrate the life and impact of our patron on his contemporaries and ourselves. Maryvale Institute (Old Oscott) was Newman's home when he first came to Birmingham. During the day there will be an opportunity to visit Newman's room and Mass will be celebrated in the chapel in which he worshipped.
